being

Correct spelling, explanation: for many learners of English the form being sounds strange, but it is just a gerund form that occurs when we add -ing to the verb -be. The original form of the verb *be* comes from Old English and later, through centuries, it evolved into the form we know today.

Definition of being:

1. noun " a person, thing, or state that exists,

I will never understand that boy, what a strange being he is.

2. gerund form " added to a verb -to be,

I really enjoy being home on my own.

Expressions with being:

The word being appears in a few commonly used expressions, these include:

1. human being " a person,

My grandmother is such a lovely human being.

2. well-being " being happy and healthy,

My well-being is the result of everyday exercise and a healthy diet.

Idioms with being with being:

1. for the time being " for now,

For the time being, we just need to stay calm and wait for the test results.

2. with every fiber of your being " it means you want something or believes in something really passionately,

He wants to complete his first marathon with every fiber of his being.

3. all things being equal " as expected,

All things being equal, I should finish the project in two days.

beeing

Incorrect spelling, explanation: it is difficult to say why, but users of English tend to double the letter -e while adding the -ing ending to the verb to be. The form beeing, however, is wrong and rather refers to a common insect

than to the verb -be.
