In what contexts can slender take the place of thin? The words slender and thin can be used in similar contexts, but slender implies leanness or spareness often with grace and good proportion. the slender legs of a Sheraton chair

When would slight be a good substitute for thin? The synonyms slight and thin are sometimes interchangeable, but slight implies smallness as well as thinness. a slight build

When is it sensible to use slim instead of thin? The words slim and thin are synonyms, but do differ in nuance. Specifically, slim applies to slenderness that suggests fragility or scantiness. a slim volume of poetry a slim chance
