Obviously, it would be "¿En QUE año?", but they marked it wrong saying it was "CUANDO" and it's nearly impossible to send that in to them. They should make it simple; why am I paying a Premium for this service when it's inaccurate at best, and when I ask for clarification, their responses are aloof? They reply to my request for a fix (or at least clarification) with things like "we need more info", but only allow for one screen shot per submission. There are at least a dozen more errors, and while I believe it would be a waste of my time reporting them all, I maintain that they are doing a HUGE disservice to their all-trusting customers. Still, though, this story program is better than some prep courses, IF the test is on this material (but it could be better if they actually valued feedback), but it's so expensive (wondering how much they pay their contributors, & could I get a free month or two for my useful corrections? I mean, they do aim for accuracy, right? Guess I'm wrong on both accounts.
